Lars did his Studies in Chinese medicine at The Acupuncture Academy in Aarhus. Later He was introduced to Japanese acupuncture by Stephen Birch at the 1.st Scandinavian TCM Congress in 2007, after that meeting he had no doubt that Japanese acupuncture was his style of acupuncture. Lars received his education in Japanese acupuncture (Toyohari) in Amsterdam with Stephen Birch and Junko Ida. Later he finished a 2 year postgraduate in Amsterdam as "Academic Toyohari practitioner"
Lars has, among others, studied with Shudo Denmai, Yutaka Shinoda, Akira Fukushima, Hitoshi Imauji, Junji Mizutani, Kiiko Matsumoto, Steven Brown, Shuho Taniuchi, Michio Murakami.

Lars runs a private acupuncture clinic in Aarhus Denmark, and teaches at Copenhagen Acupuncture School and has from 2007 - 2014. taught at The Acupuncture Academy in Aarhus and Copenhagen. Furthermore, he has assisted at the Toyohari Education in Amsterdam and at the Rothenburg TCM Congress for Yutaka Shinoda and for Stephen Birch at the 3rd Scandinavian TCM Congress in 2011.
