Suzanne Robidoux, China

Dr. Suzanne Robidoux is originally from Quebec, Canada and has been traveling and studying all over the Americas and Asia to find the best teachers of traditional medicine and martial arts. In the last 20 years she's found some interesting masters and spent a few years learning with some of them.

She moved to Taiwan in 2000 to learn Chinese and practice medicine after completing a Master's Degree in Chinese medicine in the US. She spent three years practicing internal and external martial arts and medicine with Master Li Zhang Ren. Afterwards she went to Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine to complete her Doctorates in Chinese medicine where she focused her research on treating debilitating neurological diseases. She practiced in the neurological hospital and a traditional clinics for over three years treating a wide range of neurological and psychosomatic diseases such as post stroke paralysis, multiple sclerosis, Major Depression Disease, anxiety disorders and PTSD as well as some complex gynecological diseases such as PID, infertility and uterine fibroid. She came to Beijing in 2007 and spent five years working for the People's Medical Publishing House to facilitate the translation of over 20 Chinese medical textbooks in English and in French. At the time she managed an international cooperation with China to translate and publish over 100 Chinese medical titles in over 8 different languages in the hopes to spread CM information in all parts of the world.

Presently Dr. Robidoux is a post doctorates fellow at the Beijing University of Chinese Medicine conducting a clinical trial on the application of classical thinking of the ancient doctor Zhang Zhong Jing in today's clinic with the classical expert Dr. Feng Shi Lun. Her goal is to revive the classical thinking within the Chinese medical community by systemizing it and making it readily available through online courses and books.
