Transport

There are different ways of reaching the congress center at Rønne's Hotel, Slettestrand. If you come from Denmark, you will probably prefer to travel by car, bus or train. From Norway and Sweden ferry lines are available, and if you choose to arrive by airplane, you should find a connection to Aalborg airport which is the closest airport to Slettestrand. There are direct flights between Oslo and Aalborg with British Airways. Paddy McBride MHS(TCM) President, New Zealand Register of Acupuncturists.

What do you expect to benefit from participating in the Scandinavian TCM Congress?
I hope to benefit by attending lectures given by practitioners who have not visited New Zealand, but who work in areas which are of interest to me. As well as increasing and broadening my own knowledge, it is an opportunity to meet other practitioners and lecturers who may be interested in travelling to New Zealand to lecture in the future. Having not travelled to Denmark before, I see that by attending the Scandinavian TCM Congress, I can not only learn from the lecturers at the conference but also experience a completely new country. My family had an exchange student from Denmark for a year so I am hoping also to catch up with him and his family.

What made you decide to join? A specific teacher? The surroundings? Other things (maybe advice from other TCM practitioners)?

I am travelling to Denmark with other friends from New Zealand. We attended Rothenburg in 2008 and found the experience invaluable so decided to this year visit Denmark. Peter Firebrace came to New Zealand earlier this year and Lillian Bridges is a regular visitor so I am looking forward to catching up with them again as well as meeting new people. It is always inspiring to be in the company of so many dedicated and enthusiastic practitioners of Chinese medicine.

Have you participated in other congresses? And if yes, how did you benefit from this?

I attend and present at the Australian Acupuncture and Chinese Medicine Conference each year and last year also attended Rothenburg. I also went to WFAS in Beijing in October 2007 and in Brisbane in 2004. Attending these international conferences reinforces that we are really all part of the same family – our medicine may have come from China, but there is no doubt that it is now well established all over the world. Meeting other practitioners and sharing experience and knowledge can only be of benefit – not only to those of us attending the conferences, but also to those who come to us for treatment in our own clinics.

Do you as president for a TCM organization have any comments concerning the benefits of networking internationally?

As the President of the New Zealand Register of Acupuncturists, I appreciate being able to speak with others in similar positions from throughout the world. We all face similar situations and circumstances with regard to organisational and political matters, and it is of great help to be able to share points of view and experiences. Knowing first hand of the experience and situation in other countries makes it easier for me to deal with our own politicians and decision makers, and to help steer our organisation in the right direction.
